CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength” (Mk 12:30)

“ACTIVE PARTICIPATION”

Mass is not like the typical “worship service” one finds in other Christian denominations. It is certainly not like the stage productions of the large “non-denominational” fellowships. All these are man-made meetings, often modeled on concerts or speaking events. Instead, the Mass is a “Liturgy,” which means a religious ritual established by God Himself as the official public worship of His Church, and handed down from the time of the Old Testament and the Apostles.

In the Liturgy:

- God is the focus, not man
- The altar is the focus, not a stage
- A priest is required, not a professional “minister.”
- Worship means offering sacrifice on an altar, not simply praying or giving a talk.
- Liturgical activity is transcendent—formalized in the detailed rubrics of the Church
- Christ himself acts in and through the Liturgy of his Church
- All the members of the Church who have been initiated through Baptism participate in the actions of the Sacred Liturgy.

Active Participation in the liturgy means:

- Engaging in the external rituals such as standing, kneeling, signing with the Cross.
- Saying or singing all the prayers and dialogues set forth in the rubrics
- Contributing to the offering via a personal sacrifice
- Above all, participation is interior: offering to God a just heart and holy life

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
