## CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

*“When the king came in to meet the guests, he saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. The king said to him, ‘My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?’” (Mt 22:11-12)*

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

- The Sacrament of Baptism is the gateway to all the sacraments, especially to the Eucharist. In baptism we receive the wedding garment, i.e. we are “clothed with Christ” and made worthy to enter the Church which is the banquet hall of the King.
- Baptism makes us *“Temples of the Holy Spirit”* (1 Cor 3:16, 6:19). Only the baptized may celebrate the liturgy and partake of the Eucharist.
- Through baptism we are washed clean of Original Sin and all personal sins. We become Christ’s holy bride, *“sanctified, cleansed by the washing of water with the word, that we may be presented to Christ in splendor, without spot or stain or any such thing, that we might be holy and without blemish”* (Eph 5:26-27).
- To celebrate the liturgy worthily and well, we must be in the state of grace, i.e., living in the grace of our baptismal consecration.
  
- Each time we enter the church we call to mind our Baptism by blessing ourselves with Holy Water. The water in the small fonts at each door comes from the church’s main baptism font.
- Every year on Easter Sunday we solemnly renew our Baptism vows and blessed with Holy Water. The Sprinkling Rite may be used in place of the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass.
- The funeral Mass also begins at the door of the church by calling to mind Baptism. The body in the casket is blessed with Holy Water, and clothed in the funeral pall, which represents the baptismal robe.

### **All Saints Mass:**

Mass will be celebrated at **6:45am** and **6:00pm** on Wednesday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **All Souls Mass:**

Mass will be celebrated at **6:45am** and **6:00pm** on November 2<sup>nd</sup>. After evening Mass everyone is invited to the Cemetery for the Blessing of Graves.

**CANDLES** - Sodality will have memorial candles available to place on the grave (\$5).

**NOVENA** - Enroll the names of relatives, friends, and family members who have died in this novena.

Please use the All Souls offering envelopes.

### **Religious Education**

Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists.
