CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

“SACRAMENT OF PENANCE”

“Christ loved the Church and sanctified her, that he might present the Church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish” (Eph 5:25-27)

- To celebrate the liturgy worthily and well, we must be in the state of grace, i.e., baptismal consecration.
- Mortal sins destroy the sanctification in the soul. They also harm one’s communion in the Body of Christ, requiring reconciliation to the Church.
- Mortal sins can only be forgiven through the Sacrament of Penance, where they must be confessed in kind and number.
- The Sacrament of Penance (i.e., “Confession”) absolves sins, reconciles man to God and the Church, and restores the dignity of baptism.
- Mortal Sins are listed in the 10 Commandments, which outline our duties toward God (1-3) and man (4-10). To commit a mortal sin, one must knowingly and freely violate one of the Commandments in a serious way. All three conditions are necessary for an act to be mortally sinful.
- Some important mortal sins to be aware of, which prevent one from being able to receive Holy Communion, include:
 - Curanderos, Fortune-Telling, Brujeria, Superstition (1st Commandment)
 - Missing Sunday Mass without good or justified reason (3rd Commandment)
 - Abuse of Drugs or Alcohol (5th Commandment)
 - Any sexual relationship outside the Sacrament of Matrimony (6th Commandment)
 - Artificial Contraceptives or Sterilization (6th)
 - Gossip (8th Commandment)
- Mortal sins must be repented, confessed, and avoided, so that one may be presented at Holy Communion as Christ’s Immaculate Bride.

All Saints Mass:

Mass will be celebrated at **6:45am** and **6:00pm** on Wednesday, November 1st.

All Souls Mass:

Mass will be celebrated at **6:45am** and **6:00pm** on November 2nd. After evening Mass everyone is invited to the Cemetery for the Blessing of Graves. CANDLE - Sodality will have memorial candles available to place on the grave (\$5). NOVENA - Enroll the names of relatives, friends, and family members who have died in this novena. Please use the All Souls offering envelopes.

Religious Education

All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation, there will not be CCD class. All CCD students must attend the 6:00pm Mass, especially if they will be participating in the Costume Contest. Costumes must be of any Saint the student chooses. The best costume will be awarded a prize and will also be introduced in the Mega Festival.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
