CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

“SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION”

The angel ascending from the rising of the sun with the seal of the living God sealed the servants of our God upon their foreheads (Rv 7:2-3)

- Confirmation is the sacrament by which we are fully initiated into the Catholic Church, completing the grace of baptism with the imprint of Christ's full stature on the soul, through the fire of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation gives us the power, authority, and protection of God's Name (Rv 14:1).
- Through Confirmation, we take up our role in the church community as “adult” Christians, responsible for the faith, soldiers of Christ, not merely infants.
- Through Confirmation, we participate more fully in the liturgy, and seek ways to share more fully in the apostolic and priestly ministry of the Church.
- Through Confirmation, the laity proclaim God's Word. They serve as **Readers** in the Mass, taking up the Scriptures before the community.
- Through Confirmation, the laity lead intercessory prayer for the needs of the Church and world.
- Through Confirmation, the laity prepare the liturgical celebration. They serve as **Sacristans**, caring for the sacred vessels and arranging for the items needed in the Mass.
- Through Confirmation, the laity assist the priest in bringing Holy Communion to the sick and homebound in the community.
- Through Confirmation and Matrimony, the laity lead and preside over the spiritual life of their household, and the spiritual formation of their children in the Christian life.
- Through Confirmation, the laity witness the Gospel in the workplace, through conversation and personal example.

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
