CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

“SACRAMENT OF THE EUCHARIST”

Do this in memory of me (Lk 22:19)

- The Holy Eucharist is the most important sacrament. All the other sacraments lead to it. The Eucharist completes our full initiation into the Catholic faith.
- Jesus gave the Eucharist to the Church at the Last Supper, when he fulfilled the Jewish Passover by making himself the Passover Lamb.
- In the Eucharist, Jesus gives the sacrifice of his Body and Blood by means of the bread and wine blessed during the Passover meal. The bread becomes his flesh, the wine becomes his blood.
- The bread and wine are not just symbols of his body and blood. Jesus said, “*Take this bread and eat it, this is my body.*” And likewise with the wine: “*Take this chalice and drink it, this is my blood.*”
- Matthew (26:26-27), Mark (14:22-25), Luke (22:17-19), and Paul (1Cor 11:23-26) all stress Jesus’ exact words and actions at the Last Supper, which are recounted solemnly every time we celebrate Mass.
- St. John also devotes an entire chapter (Jn 6) to the sacrament of the Eucharist, presenting the long discourse where Jesus proclaims he is the “*bread of life,*” the “*true bread from heaven,*” whose flesh and blood are “*real food and real drink*” (Jn 6:55).
- The Eucharist is shocking, and at first people do not understand why Jesus would do this. Jesus explains it is necessary for eternal life (Jn 6:54).
- It is the *risen* flesh and blood of Jesus, glorified in heaven and no longer subject to death or corruption, that we consume in Holy Communion. The Eucharist brings into our flesh and blood the elements of eternal life, the grace of our own future resurrection.
- The disciples recognized the risen Lord “*in the breaking of Bread*” (Lk 24:35). We too recognize the Lord Jesus in the Real Presence of the Eucharist. We show this by *genuflecting* when we enter and leave the church, and by kneeling during the consecration.
