CELEBRATING THE LITURGY WORTHILY AND WELL

“SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY”

*“Husbands, love your wives as Christ loves the Church”
(Eph 5:25)*

- The Church is the Bride of Christ, and the Mass is the “wedding supper” of the divine Lamb with his Bride.
- In the Sacrament of Matrimony, the groom represents Christ, the bride represents the Church. Husband and wife are to love and serve each other the way Christ loves the Church.
- Catholics must marry with the Church’s blessing. Civil marriages of Catholics are “invalid,” they are not sacramental unions.
- Matrimony union is accomplished by God Himself through the power of the Holy Spirit. By their vows, man and woman give free consent for God to unite them into one. The bond of matrimony is permanent, unconditional, and irrevocable.
- *“What God has joined together, man may not separate”* (Mt 19:6). Not even the pope can change or annul a valid sacramental marriage. Only death ends the bond of matrimony.
- Marriage fulfills the mission of the Church, where the Lord sends his disciples “two by two” into the towns and neighborhoods, to establish his Kingdom within a household (Lk 10:1-12).
- Jesus’ first miracle was to provide for the celebration of a wedding as a sign of the Kingdom of God (Jn 2:1-12).
- As Mary obtained from her son the miracle of changing water into fine wine, the Church helps married couples experience the rich graces of Christ when they encounter human limitations. God works through difficult circumstances, and even a suffering marriage can serve the advancement of the Kingdom of God.

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
