20 DO’S AND DONT’S

“My Father gives you the true bread from heaven”
(Jn 6:32)

#2 No Food or Drink in Church.

- In the Liturgy of the Eucharist we participate in the “heavenly banquet of the Lamb.” At the Last Supper Jesus established the new and eternal covenant through the Passover meal.
- In the Eucharist we receive the “true bread from heaven.” Out of respect for the Body and Blood of the Lord, we do not bring outside food and drink into the Church.
- The only food allowed in the church is the special sacramental bread and wine that will be brought up in the offertory procession and consecrated during the Eucharistic prayer.
- On certain special occasions, bread will be blessed during the Mass and distributed for parishioners to take home.
- An exception to the rule against food and drink is baby formula for *infants* who are nursing. Do not bring snacks or candy for *toddlers*. They are old enough to wait one hour.
- Another exception is medicine.
- This rule is not just saying “do not eat” in church. It is never appropriate to *bring* food, snacks, or drink into the church. This applies during regular Mass times, but also at other times, when visiting or performing other tasks in the church.
- This rule applies to Catholics, non-Catholics, visitors, contractors, maintenance crews, and anyone who might need to come into the church for any reason.
- Of course, this rule definitely applies to chewing gum, and also tobacco products.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
