20 DO'S AND DONT'S

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh" (Jn 6:51)

#3 Don't chew gum in church!

- Even though this is already covered by other rules (fasting before Mass, and not bringing food and drink into the church), this one needs its own rule, because it is such a common problem. People chew gum out of habit, and often forget or don't even realize.
- Chewing gum is candy, i.e. food. It breaks the Eucharistic fast. You may not receive Holy Communion if you chewed gum during the hour before Mass.
- Chewing gum is highly distracting for those trying to pray. It is very impolite in a formal occasion. (Think about cows chewing cud).
- People often dispose of chewing gum on the ground, sidewalks, and parking lots. It gets stuck on people's shoes and gets carried into the buildings. This is littering, which is a sin. Worst of all, people stick it under pews! Don't believe me? Take a look sometime.
- If you walk into church chewing gum, the priest or usher may ask you to dispose of it. Please dispose of chewing gum in the restroom trashcan, not on the ground or parking lot, before entering the church.
- Please do not get offended if you are asked to dispose of gum. Please respect God's house.

Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
