## “MASS ETIQUETTE”

### 20 DO'S AND DONT'S

#### #4 Bless yourself with Holy Water

*“Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19)*

- By means of the sacrament of Baptism we enter the Church and become members of God's household.
- Stoups containing blessed baptismal water (“Holy Water”) are located at each entrance of a Catholic church.
- Whenever you enter the church building, bless yourself with Holy Water as a reminder of Baptism, and the purification needed in order to celebrate the Holy Eucharist.
- Holy Water has special power from the Holy Spirit to overcome evil. It can repulse demons, strengthen the fight against sin, and increase peace. Used with faith, many miracles have occurred by means of Holy Water.
- When blessing yourself, use your right hand and touch the water with your fingers. Then, make the sign of the Cross over yourself by touching your forehead, stomach, left shoulder, and right shoulder (in that order), while saying the words “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”
- Recently, a practice has started of also touching behind one's neck. This seems to be superstition, and it is not part of the Sign of the Cross. *Do not do this.*
- Besides blessing yourself when entering the church, also bless yourself when leaving.

Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

## SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar ([olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar](http://olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar)) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
