## **“MASS ETIQUETTE”**

### **20 DO’S AND DONT’S**

#### **#4 Dress Modestly and Appropriately**

*“Worship the Lord in holy array” (Ps 96:9)*

- In the Old Testament, people were urged to dress in festive clothing (“holy array”) when coming to worship.
- In the New Testament, the Apostles urged Christians to dress modestly, not with excessive jewelry or display (1 Tm 2:9, 1 Pt 3:3).
- When we come to Mass, clothing should reflect the importance of the Liturgy, which is a formal celebration, a joyful occasion, a solemn ceremony, in a holy place.
- Each person should make his own judgment as to the proper clothing for himself and his family, but some general guidelines can be helpful.
- Modesty: clothing which is provocative or calls attention to the body in a distracting way is inappropriate. Generally, shoulders and knees should be covered. Clothing should not be tight or sheer.
- Shorts, t-shirts, play clothes, sportswear, work clothes, school clothes, clothing with decals, clothing that proclaim a brand or other message or which promotes something are not appropriate on a Sunday celebration (unless exceptional circumstances). Special clothes should be purchased for attending Mass, to highlight the special dignity of the Liturgy.
- Christians should “dress up” more formally for Sunday Mass. For women, this could mean a nice dress or outfit; for men it could mean slacks and buttoned shirt; for children and youth it means dress clothes and dress shoes instead of school clothes.

## SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar ([olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar](http://olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar)) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
