"MASS ETIQUETTE" 20 DO'S AND DONT'S

#3 Don't Chew Gum in Church!

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh" (Jn 6:51)

- In the Eucharist we receive the "living Bread come down from heaven." Out of respect for the Body and Blood of the Lord, we do not bring outside food and drink into the Church.
- The only food allowed in the church is the special sacramental bread and wine that will be brought up in the offertory procession and consecrated during the Eucharistic prayer.
- Chewing gum is candy, i.e. food. It is not permitted in the church.
- Chewing gum breaks the Eucharistic fast. You are not prepared to receive Holy Communion if you chewed gum during the hour before Mass.
- Chewing gum is highly distracting. It is very impolite in a formal occasion.
- People often dispose of chewing gum on the ground, sidewalks, and parking lots. It gets stuck on people's shoes and gets carried into the buildings. Worst of all, people sometimes stick it under pews for ushers and sacristans to clean.
- If you walk into church chewing gum, the priest or usher may ask you to dispose of it. Please dispose of chewing gum in the restroom trashcan, before entering the church.
- Please do not get offended if you are asked to dispose of gum. Please respect God's house.

Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
