#6 Take off hats, Put on veils

“Any man who prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head, but any woman who prays or prophesies with her head unveiled dishonors her head” (1 Cor 11:4-5)

- It was the custom of the Church (until the 1960s) for men to remove their hats when entering the church, and for women to cover their heads with a veil when in the church.
- This is not a law, but a custom. While not required, it is commended. Many women today who veil their heads in church use a lace veil called a “mantilla.”
- In the Church, Christ is the “Head” (Col 1:18). The Church is the “Bride” of Christ, under his Headship (Eph 5:23-29). To show reverence for Christ the Head, women (who represent in a way the Church) veil their heads; while the men (who represent in a way Christ’s headship) unveil their heads.
- St. Paul says women who maintain long hair already have a kind of natural veil (1 Cor 11:15).
- Even if laity do not observe this ancient custom, Religious sisters (at least the traditional ones) always wear a veil as part of their religious habit. Bishops who represent Christ most perfectly in the Church, accentuate their headship by wearing the miter. When they stand in the person of Christ at the Eucharist, they completely unveil their heads, removing the zucchetto (skull cap).
- Modern man has lost a sense of reverence and respect for God and the sacredness of His House. Modern man does not understand that the veil is a sign of the sacred. Feminists deny the distinct role of women in the Church. Perhaps this ancient custom should be reconsidered and promoted again?

If you would like a candle, please contact a Little Flower Sodality member, a Sacristan or stop by the Rectory Office during business hours. Our candles are \$5. They are taller and are in a glass container, because of this they last longer. Most important, our devotional candles use genuine beeswax, not synthetic wax like the store-bought ones.

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
