“MASS ETIQUETTE” 20 DO’S AND DONT’S

#7 Arrive Early, Leave Late

“After receiving the morsel of bread, Judas immediately went out” (Jn 13:30).

- Judas left the Last Supper early. We must respect the integrity and completeness of the Mass, from beginning to end.
- The only exception is those who need to attend to an emergency, or deal with a crying child.
- **Mass begins** with the gathering of God’s people under the sign of the Cross, solemn greeting, and the Penitential Rite which prepares us for the celebration of the Eucharist. These ceremonies are an integral part of the Mass, and must not be skipped or missed.
- Arriving early allows time for personal prayer and preparation. There may also be announcements or messages before Mass (such as Bishop’s annual appeal), or processions that begin outside the church (such as Palm Sunday).
- If you do arrive late, be discreet, do not interrupt the readings, and sit toward the back.
- **Mass ends** with announcements (which is the pastor’s opportunity to address “housekeeping” items), solemn blessing, and the “sending.” We do not leave Mass by our decision. Christ “sends” us on our mission: *“Ite, missa est”* (“Go forth, you are sent”).
- Wait for the solemn procession and final hymn to finish, and sometimes a devotion such as the “Prayer of St. Michael.” After Mass is a perfect time for thanksgiving prayer and family devotions.
- Finally, don’t forget to greet the priest! He is the spiritual father of the parish, and needs to meet all the parishioners, learning their names and faces.

MINISTRY FORMATION CLASS

Fr Mullan will be teaching a class each month to deepen our knowledge and love of the Mass. Everyone is invited. These classes will also serve as workshops for parish ministries.

Next Class: TBA in the Parish Hall. *All Sacristans, and those interested in being sacristans, need to attend.*

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend the Baptism Preparation meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
