"MASS ETIQUETTE" 20 DO'S AND DONT'S

#8 Turn off cellphones in Church

*"Jesus said to them, 'it is written,
"My house shall be called a house of prayer"'"
(Mt 21:13)*

- The Church is a house of prayer, which means our focus is on conversation with the Lord.
- We need to leave behind or put away any distracting devices that can interrupt prayer.
- Place phone in silent mode, and if it rings by accident, turn it off as quickly as possible.
- Cell phones should never be used in Mass for calls or texting, unless it is a true emergency, such as calling "911." If it is non-emergency, but some very important matter, please step outside to place the call or text.
- Electronic devices should never be used in church to play games or watch videos.
- It is important that children learn from earliest age how to pray and listen to God. Toys and other distractions are not brought to church.
- Smartphones may be used as a devotional aid, however. It is acceptable to use them for devotional prayers, for the Mass readings, Liturgy of the Hours, or Confession preparation.

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Baptism"). Baptisms will be held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. These are offered monthly on Wednesdays – please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the Bible class on Wednesdays from 7-8PM at any time (please check off the column marked "Marriage").
