20 DO'S AND DON'TS AT CHURCH

#1 Fast before Mass.

"I am the Bread of Life" (Jn 6:35)

- It is Church law to fast for at least one hour before Mass. The purpose is to help us prepare to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Jesus said, "I am the bread of life, the true bread come down from heaven" (Jn 6:50-51). In honor of the heavenly Bread, we abstain from earthly bread.
- Some people ask, is the fast one hour before Mass begins, or one hour before Holy Communion? Answer: the measure you use will be used against you (Lk 6:38). We need to be generous with God, not stingy. We should therefore fast at least one hour. If you can't even fast for one hour before Mass begins, you should not receive Holy Communion. It used to be that Catholics fasted from midnight. Only after Mass did they eat the meal known as "break-fast."
- If parents follow this rule, and train their children to follow this rule, there would rarely be a need for children (or adults) to get up during Mass to use the restroom, except for special situations and emergencies.
- The law of fasting does not apply for water and medicine. People who suffer from diabetes or other medical conditions that require eating on a fixed schedule are exempt from fasting. The sick, hospitalized, and homebound are exempt from fasting and may receive Holy Communion whenever the minister can visit them.
- The rule definitely applies to chewing gum. Out of reverence for the Holy Eucharist do not chew gum in the church building

Religious Education - Registration

Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
