## SACRAMENT OF THE EUCHARIST

*“My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink” (Jn 6:55)*

- St. John devotes an entire chapter (Jn 6) to the sacrament of the Eucharist, presenting a long discourse where Jesus proclaims he is the “bread of life,” the “true bread from heaven,” whose flesh and blood are real food and drink (Jn 6:55).
- Jesus explains to the people that he will give them a bread from heaven, like the Manna in the desert, and that he himself is this bread: “I am the true bread come down from heaven; I am the Bread of Life” (Jn 6:35,51).
- Jesus also explains that he will give himself as spiritual “bread for the soul” by means of actual bread and wine (Jn 6:51-55). The Church has always understood that in the Eucharist, bread and wine are truly changed into Christ’s actual body and blood, and are no longer the substance of bread and wine.
- It is the risen flesh and blood of Jesus, glorified in heaven and no longer subject to death or corruption, that we consume in Holy Communion. The Eucharist brings to our flesh and blood the elements of eternal life, the grace of our own future resurrection.
- The Eucharist is a very shocking thing, and at first people do not understand why Jesus would do this. Jesus explains it is necessary for eternal life: “he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life” (Jn 6:54).
- On Easter Sunday, the disciples recognized the Lord “in the breaking of Bread” (Lk 24:35). We too recognize the Lord Jesus in the Real Presence of the Eucharist. We show this recognition by genuflecting when we enter and leave the church, and by kneeling during the consecration of the Mass.

Please see parish calendar ([olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar](http://olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar)) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar ([olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar](http://olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar)) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
