SACRAMENT OF THE EUCHARIST

“Do this in memory of me” (Lk 22:19)

- The Holy Eucharist is the central and most important of all seven sacraments. All the other sacraments lead to it. The Eucharist completes our full initiation into the Catholic faith.
- Jesus gave the Eucharist to the Church at the Last Supper. The Eucharist fulfills the Jewish Passover. In the Eucharist, Jesus himself becomes the Passover Lamb, whose blood saves God’s people.
- In the Eucharist, Jesus gives the sacrifice of his body and blood by means of the bread and wine blessed during the Passover. The bread is his flesh, the wine is his blood.
- The bread and wine are not just symbols of his body and blood. Jesus said, “Take this bread and eat it, this is my body.” And likewise with the wine: “Take this chalice and drink it, this is my blood”
- St. Matthew (Mt 26:26-27), St. Mark (Mk 14:22-25), St. Luke (Lk 22:17-19), and St. Paul (1Cor 11:23-26) all stress Jesus’ exact words and actions at the Last Supper, which are recounted solemnly every time we celebrate Mass.

Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
