20 DO'S AND DON'TS IN CHURCH

#14 – Care for the Pews

“Jesus reclined at the table with his disciples” (Mt 26:17).

- Mass is a holy banquet in which Jesus shares the sacred meal of his Body and Blood.
- To facilitate the worthy celebration of Mass, the Church utilizes special benches called pews.
- Pews are specially designed so that people may easily sit, stand, and kneel. They are also designed so that people may join with each other as a community, and not be isolated from one another.
- In most churches, pews are donated by families who form the pillars of that community. They are important furnishings, and cost \$3000-\$4000 each.
- Pews need to be used correctly, and cared for well.
- When **sitting**, sit with attentive posture, not lounging or slouching. Please train small children to sit facing forward and not climb on the pews.
- When **kneeling**, lower the kneeler gently and quietly, and afterward lift the kneeler quietly.
- When **standing**, stand uprightly without leaning on the pew in front with your hands. Please train teenagers to stand with respect and not slouch.
- Do not wear external accessories that scratch the pews, such as metallic belts, chains, or keys.
- Please be vigilant for anyone who is scratching, carving, writing on, or otherwise vandalizing our church pews. This seems to be a problem especially in the back of the church.
- **DO NOT DISPOSE OF CHEWING GUM UNDER THE PEWS.** Do not chew gum in the church at all, and dispose all chewing gum outside in a trash can before Mass, not the sidewalk.
- If you wish to volunteer to assist with the cleaning and maintenance of pews, please contact the office. This task is done on Saturday mornings.

Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
