20 DO’S AND DON’TS IN CHURCH

#15 – Use Missallettes and Hymnals

“Sing to the Lord a new song” (Ps 96:1).

- When the Church celebrates the Liturgy, every baptized member participates, and has a role to play. The whole congregation sings and prays to God; interacts in dialogue with the priest; listens and responds to God’s word. To assist with following the Mass and participating fully, most parishes provide Missallettes and Hymnals in the pews.
- Missallettes are published seasonally, and include the readings, Mass parts, and a selection of hymns for that time period. These are available in English and Spanish. In addition, Missallettes often have other devotional prayers.
- Missallettes greatly assist the congregation to follow along with the readings, especially if the sound system is not good, or the lector is hard to understand. They are arranged to follow the Mass sequentially, and organize the readings by calendar date.
- A Hymnal is a more permanent book that contains a large selection of standard and traditional hymns, which can be used throughout the entire Church calendar. Hymns are religious poetry set to music, that follow a standard poetic meter, and celebrate a particular liturgical theme. Some of the Church’s traditional hymns are over a thousand years old; they are part of the Church’s artistic heritage.
- Please use the books with care so that they will last a long time. Do not fold or tear pages; do not write in them. Do not allow children – especially toddlers – to play with the books. If you accidentally damage a hymnal, please offer to buy a replacement for the parish (\$15-\$25). Individuals who wish to purchase a Missallette for themselves can make arrangements with the office. Missallettes are free for any parishioners who are homebound.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend the monthly Baptism Preparation meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance (usually first Sundays). Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
