FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

*“Whenever the Ark set out, Moses said, ‘Arise, O Lord, and let your enemies be scattered; and let them who hate you flee before you’”
(Nm 10:35)*

- A Corpus Christi procession is a public expression of the Church’s mission to evangelize the world.
- Procession will take place **Sunday, June 3, 11am-12pm**. It begins at Our Lady of Guadalupe, immediately following the 10:00am Sunday Mass. It concludes at Sacred Heart parish, following their 10:30am Sunday Mass.
- All Catholics from Sinton are asked to participate. If you are not attending the 10am Mass, please arrive at the OLG parking lot by 11am and wait outside the front of the church.
- The procession will proceed up Sodville Street to the light, then down Sinton Street to Sacred Heart Church. Total distance is less than 1 mile; walking time will be about 30 minutes.
- Order of Procession: Cross, flower girls (Sodality) and first communicants, priest with Blessed Sacrament, altar servers, choir, parish organizations (Guadalupanas), congregation.
- Those who made First Holy Communion can walk in front, dressed in white. Parish organizations can walk behind their banners.
- You may use umbrellas for the sun. Please keep a prayerful spirit: singing, praying the Rosary.
- Upon arrival at Sacred Heart, we will enter the church, where Benediction will take place.
- Following the procession, Sacred Heart parishioners will drive parishioners back to OLG.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend the monthly Baptism Preparation meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance (usually first Sundays). Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
