MASS ETIQUETTE

20 Do's and Don'ts

#12 – Prepare your offering before Mass

“Every tithe (tenth) of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the Lord's; it is holy to the Lord” (Lv 27:30)

- In order for the ushers to take up the collection quickly and efficiently, please have your offering ready to drop in before the basket passes by.
- The offering given at Mass represents the portion of one's income set aside as a return to Lord, which acknowledges that all blessings come from God and we depend on Him. The offering is a “thanksgiving” sacrifice.
- One's tithe must be a substantial contribution toward the real expenses of the Church, and never simply “loose change” or “whatever extra I have today.” Each household should plan their tithe as part of the monthly household budget and expenses.
- The greater part of one's tithe is given to the local parish church, to maintain operations and expenses. A smaller portion of one's tithe is given to the bishop for diocesan needs, as well as to second collections that fund national and international apostolates of the Church.
- How much? In the Old Testament, the amount was specified as a “tithe,” which means one “tenth.” In the New Testament each Christian is free to determine the appropriate amount based on his income and personal situation (Acts 4:32-5:11). However, 10% is still the general guideline.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

Next Baptism Preparation Meeting: Sunday, July 1, 2pm

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
