Statement on Immigration
 The Most Reverend Michael Mulvey
 Bishop of Corpus Christi
 June 20, 2018

To the Catholic Faithful of the Diocese of Corpus Christi,

As bishop of the Diocese of Corpus Christi and as a citizen of this great country, I express my consternation and bewilderment over the separation of children from their parents at the U.S./Mexico border. Regardless of whether a person is legal or illegal, an immigrant or a person seeking asylum, it is inhumane to detain and more so to separate children from their loved ones. We have seen the pictures and heard the audios of children crying “mama” and “papa”. The dignity of human life and the rights of innocent children and their parents are on trial here.

We are a country based on laws, but more so we are characterized as a country that has a heart especially for those who are suffering and live in fear as expressed on the Statue of Liberty:

*“Give me your tired, your poor,
 Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,
 The wretched refuse of your teeming shore.
 Send these, the homeless, tempest-tossed to me,
 I lift my lamp beside the golden door!”*

In all situations the dignity of human life must be secured.

Let us not harden our hearts, brothers and sisters. It is not the time for us to choose sides and become more divided than we already are. As followers of Jesus, himself an immigrant, we are urged not to get caught in this political

polarization, but to rise above it. Are we not to respond to the least as we would to Jesus himself?

I ask you to pray with me for everyone involved, for those who agree with us and those who do not. I also ask you to express to our Representatives in Washington to seek a resolution as soon as possible.

May the Holy Spirit remind us and guide us to fulfill all that Jesus commands us and to give us the courage to live as his disciples in this most difficult situation.

Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
