## 20 DO'S AND DONT'S AT MASS

### #16 – Receive Holy Communion with Reverence

*Let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe” (Hb 12:28)*

- When receiving Holy Communion while standing (custom in the United States), make an act of reverence first, such as bowing or genuflecting.
- Pope Benedict XVI encouraged the traditional practice of kneeling to receive Holy Communion. The Church explicitly affirms the right of the faithful to receive Holy Communion while kneeling if they so choose, even if the general custom is to stand.
- It is also the long-standing tradition of the Church to receive communion directly in the mouth, without handling the Sacrament oneself. This is the first and recommended option.
- When receiving Holy Communion in the hand (second option), the host is placed on the left hand, right hand underneath. If using this option, the sacred host is never to be “grabbed” or “taken” out of the hand of the minister, only received humbly in the gesture of a beggar.
- When receiving Holy Communion in the hand, examine the hand carefully and consume any small particles of the Eucharist that may have fallen off. The priest is required to purify his hands after Holy Communion with clean water (which is then consumed) as part of the ritual. If laity handle Holy Communion with their hands, should they not do the same after Mass?
- If Holy Communion is offered under both kinds (Body and Blood of the Lord), and the Precious Blood is offered directly from a chalice, exercise great care when receiving and handling the chalice. Take only a small sip. Ensure that no lipstick or lip gloss is left on the chalice or purificator. I.E., those who will receive the Precious Blood from the chalice should not use any lipstick or lip gloss during that Mass.

Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar ([olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar](http://olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar)) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
