20 DO'S AND DONT'S AT MASS

#17 – Vigilance for the Holy Eucharist

“Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord.” (1 Cor 11:27)

- Every Catholic is responsible for maintaining reverence and respect for the Eucharist in our churches.
- The sanctuary lamp is always kept burning as a reminder of the Real Presence. If you notice the lamp has gone out, please inform the sacristan as soon as possible.
- When receiving Holy Communion, the host must be consumed at once.
- Be vigilant for anyone who does not consume the Sacred Host, takes a Host back to the pew, or tries to take a Sacred Host out of church. Please speak to the person at once, and inform the priest as soon as possible.
- In all cases where the Eucharist is in danger of being profaned, inform the priest at once.
- Please help any non-Catholic visitors or non-believers feel welcome at Mass, but also understand that they are not able to receive Holy Communion.
- If a Sacred Host ever falls on the floor, it must be picked up and returned to the priest immediately. The floor will be wiped with a purificator.
- If the Precious Blood is accidentally spilled, a purificator is immediately used to wipe the spill, and after Mass the area is purified with clean water.
- In a situation where a Sacred Host can no longer be consumed, the priest will dissolve it in a special ablution placed in the tabernacle.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend the monthly Baptism Preparation meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance (usually first Sundays). Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Parents need to be registered parishioners, active in their faith. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Parents can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in). Baptisms are normally held after the 8:00am Mass on Sunday.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend the monthly Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance (usually fourth Sundays), to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. Please see parish calendar (olgsinton.org/parish-events-calendar) for upcoming dates. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required Bible class on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
